DO NOT PUT BATTÉRIES AND CELL PHONES IN WITH YOUR HOUSEHOLD WASTE

The following items will be charged the regular tipping fee:

Fridge, Freezer or Air Conditioner - \$60.00 or Decommissioned \$15.00

Commercial Construction Waste - \$78.00/cubic yard

If you do not have a vehicle, pickup for appliances will be May 28th.
